WHAT IS COMMUNITY SUPPORTED *Agriculture*

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is more than a subscription—it's a direct link to the freshest, most flavorful food your local farm has to offer. As a member, you invest in the farm at the start of the season and, in return, receive a share of the harvest throughout the growing months. Each box is a celebration of the season, packed with just-picked produce, harvested at peak ripeness, and delivered straight to your table.

But CSA is about more than just food — it's about connection. You'll know exactly where your food comes from, who grows it, how it's cultivated, and why it matters. It's a delicious way to eat seasonally, explore new flavors, and support the farmers who nourish your community.

By joining a CSA, you're saying yes — to vibrant, just-harvested food, thriving local farms, and a deeper connection to what's on your plate. Ready to taste the difference? Your farm-fresh adventure starts here.

 Be certified organic or in transition to the organic certification

 Demonstrate a high level of customer service to their members year after year

 Grow and produce the majority of the products they offer in their shares on their own farm

HOW DOES IT *Work*

- 1 START WITH THE BASICS**
How many people are in your household? How often do you want to receive your share? Is your household made up of adventurous eaters, or do you want to stick to the staples? Knowing these answers will help you find the right share for your needs.
- 2 SIGN UP**
Choose a local farm offering CSA memberships and select the share size and options that fit your household. Sign up for your share on your farm's website.
- 3 RECEIVE YOUR SHARES**
Throughout the growing season, you'll regularly receive freshly harvested, seasonal produce. Each share reflects what's growing at the moment, from early spring greens to late-summer tomatoes and fall squash. Some farms may also offer add-ons like eggs, flowers, bread, or meat.
- 4 EXPERIENCE YOUR FARM**
Many farms keep members updated through newsletters, which can include farm news, storage tips, and recipes to help you make the most of your share. Some farms also offer opportunities to visit the farm and attend farm events.



5 *Enjoy* THE *Bounty*

Use your produce to create fresh, seasonal meals. Explore new flavors and feel good knowing you're supporting farmers using sustainable and organic farming practices.



WHAT KIND OF CSA IS *Right* FOR *You*

A CSA share was traditionally a box of whatever the farm was harvesting each week, with every member receiving the same items. While CSA members can still choose that as an option, many farmers now offer more personalization to account for preferences, taste, and lifestyle.

Here are the four main types of CSA shares — see which might be the best fit for you!

TRADITIONAL CSA

Members receive an assortment of produce weekly or bi-weekly with box contents determined by the farmers.

MARKET-STYLE CSA

"Shop" for your share from what's available that week at a designated pick-up spot or farmers' market stand.

MARKET CARD CSA

Make an up-front deposit and receive a card to spend on produce throughout the season (similar to a gift card).

CUSTOMIZABLE CSA

Customize the contents of your box based on what you like best; swap out items you don't like and choose more of what you enjoy.



Our belief is healthy land produces healthy food, which in turn builds a healthy person.





CSA: A CHOICE FOR YOUR *Health*

Are you looking to eat more fresh foods this year? A CSA share ensures you always have the freshest, tastiest ingredients on your table. Eighty-eight percent of people say they eat healthier because of CSA!

CSA Members:

- Cook with a greater variety of ingredients
- Eat more servings of fresh vegetables and fruits
- Enjoy nutrient-dense produce, picked at the peak of ripeness
- Get new recipes and cooking advice from their farmers

CSA: A CHOICE FOR THE *Land*

Knowing your farmer means knowing how your food is grown — FairShare farmers want to get to know you and are proud to tell you about their growing practices.

Choosing a CSA from a Certified Organic farm means:

- No genetically modified organism (GMO) crops
- No toxic chemicals that contaminate our waterways or harm pollinators
- Regenerative growing practices that build soil and heal the land

Joining a CSA isn't just a healthier choice for you; it's also a partnership that supports soil health, biodiversity, sustainable growing practices, and a resilient local food system.

CSA: AN OPTION FOR *Affordability*

FairShare works to ensure that everyone can have access to fresh organic food!

- The average cost of a weekly vegetable CSA share is \$35/wk for a standard share (great for around 3-4 ppl) and \$25/wk for a small share (perfect for around 1-2 ppl). A great value for farm-fresh produce harvested just for your household!
- Our Partner Shares Program offers eligible households up to \$350 of assistance toward the purchase of fresh produce. We're also able to process SNAP benefits!
- Many farms now offer flexible payment plans to spread the share cost across the season.

3 Explore YOUR RESULTS

It's likely that a number of different farms will meet your search criteria. Explore your results using the following tools, and find the farm that's right for you.

MAP

Use the map to see where pick-up sites and farms are located. Farm locations are helpful for households interested in on-farm pick-up, on-farm events, or worker shares.

FARM LISTING

A list of all our farms, along with a brief description, is located beneath the map. This list will narrow down based on which farms meet your search criteria.

FARM PROFILE

Explore each farm, in depth, on their farm profiles. Profiles include a detailed farm description, share information, languages spoken, farm-specific pick-up locations, and photos.

EAT WITH THE Seasons

Each farm is unique and grows a wide range of varieties and types of fruits and vegetables. But no matter the farm, your CSA share will always feature fresh, seasonal produce – your food is picked at the peak of ripeness and travels straight from the farm to your table for a more flavorful, vibrant taste!

Here are some examples of what you might receive in a standard share in the following months:

August

- Watermelon
- 3 lb. Tomatoes
- 3 Summer Squash
- Cucumbers
- 1 Head Garlic
- Bell Peppers
- 2 Heads Broccoli
- 1 Bunch Swiss Chard
- Fresh Basil

October

- 3 lb. Potatoes
- 5 Onions
- Butternut Squash
- Pie Pumpkin
- Celeriac
- 1 Bunch Kale
- 1 Bunch Carrots
- Napa Cabbage
- Sweet Potatoes

June

- 1 Medium Bag Arugula
- 1 Head Lettuce
- 2 Bulbs Kohlrabi
- 1 Bunch Radishes
- 2 Pints Strawberries
- 1 Bunch Asparagus
- 1 Bunch Green Garlic
- 1 Bunch Curly Kale
- Fresh Mint

*Additional search criteria include optional add-on items (eggs, meat, fruit, or specialty products), along with pick-up day



